BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Jesus prayed in a garden, knowing it was almost time for Him to die.
- Judas brought a crowd to arrest Jesus.
- Jesus was arrested though He did nothing wrong.

KEY PASSAGE: Philippians 2:8

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- What did Jesus do to save us? Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

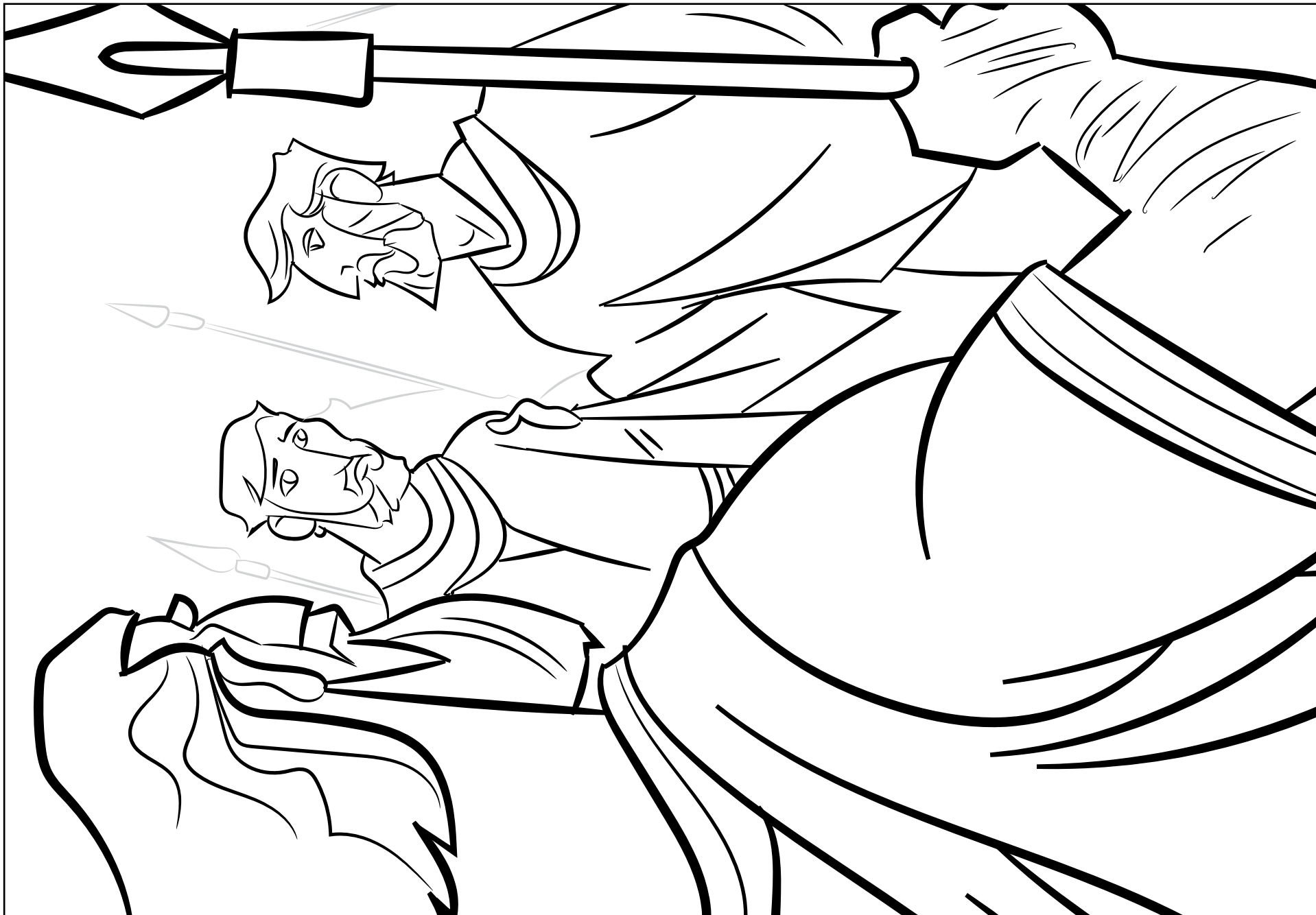
- Why was Jesus sad while He prayed?

- Look online for names of believers who have been imprisoned for their faith. Pray for them as a family.

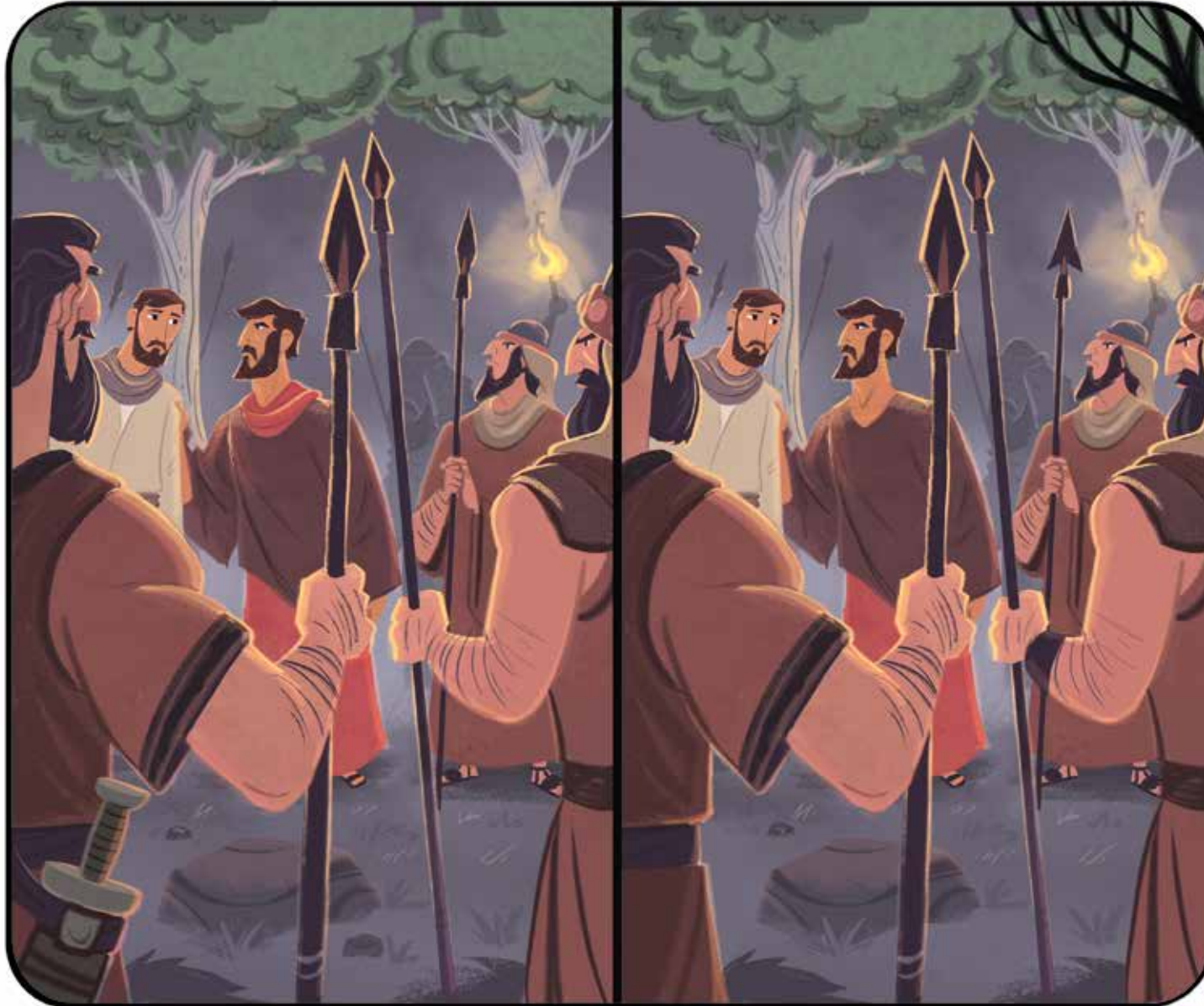

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Jesus and His disciples went to a garden to pray.
- Jesus asked God for a way to avoid dying but said He wanted to do God's plan.
- Judas betrayed Jesus with a kiss to show Jesus' enemies who to arrest.
- Jesus allowed His enemies to arrest Him.

KEY PASSAGE: Philippians 2:8

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- What did Jesus do to save us? Jesus lived a sinless life, died on the cross, and rose from the dead.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why do you think Jesus was afraid to die on the cross?
- Are you ever afraid to obey God?
- How can we obey God when things are very difficult or scary?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Find a prison ministry near you. Contact the ministry to see if your family can put together encouraging cards and simple gifts for the prisoners. Talk to your kids about how Jesus was arrested despite never sinning.

Jesus Was Arrested

Matthew 26–27

STORY POINT: JESUS ALLOWED HIS ENEMIES TO ARREST HIM.

Jesus came with His disciples to a garden. Jesus took three of His disciples into the garden, and Jesus became very sad and troubled. He fell facedown and prayed, "Father! If it is possible, spare Me from this. But I want to do Your plan."

Jesus came back and found the three disciples asleep. Jesus went away and prayed a second time. Then He said, "Get up, for it is almost time. Someone is going to betray Me."

Suddenly Judas arrived with a large crowd carrying swords and clubs. The men grabbed Jesus and arrested Him. Jesus' followers ran away, but Peter stayed nearby to watch. The men who arrested Jesus led Him to the high priest. The religious leaders wanted a reason to kill Jesus, but they couldn't find one. The high priest asked, "Are You the Messiah, the Son of God?"

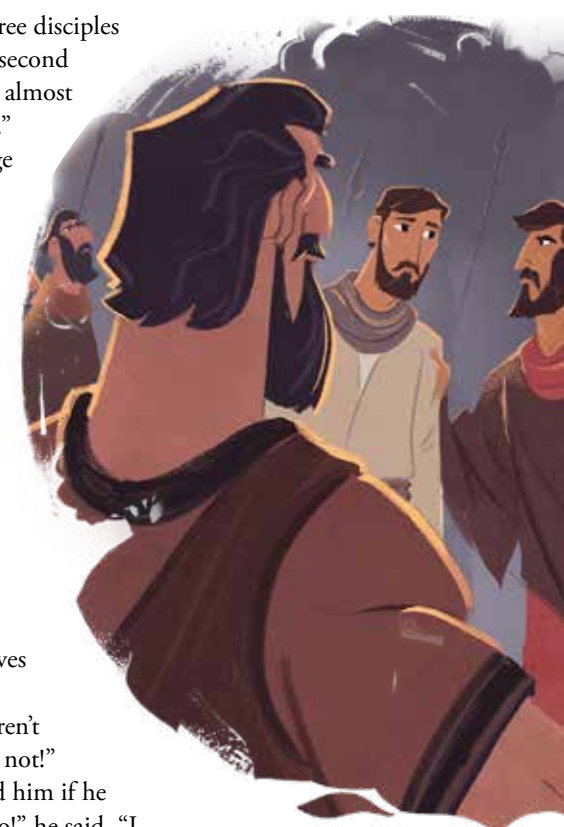
Jesus replied, "Yes, that's right."

Caiaphas and the religious leaders did not want to believe that Jesus is God's Son. They said Jesus was lying. The crowd said, "He deserves to die!"

A servant saw Peter and asked, "Aren't you one of Jesus' disciples?" "No, I'm not!" Peter said. Twice more someone asked him if he was a follower of Jesus. Peter lied. "No!" he said. "I don't even know Him!"

The next morning, the religious leaders decided how they would kill Jesus. Then they took Him to Pilate, the governor.

Christ Connection: Jesus knew that His death was God's plan to save people from sin. Jesus' friends turned against Him and He was arrested and put on trial, but Jesus followed His Father's plan in order to bring salvation to the world.
