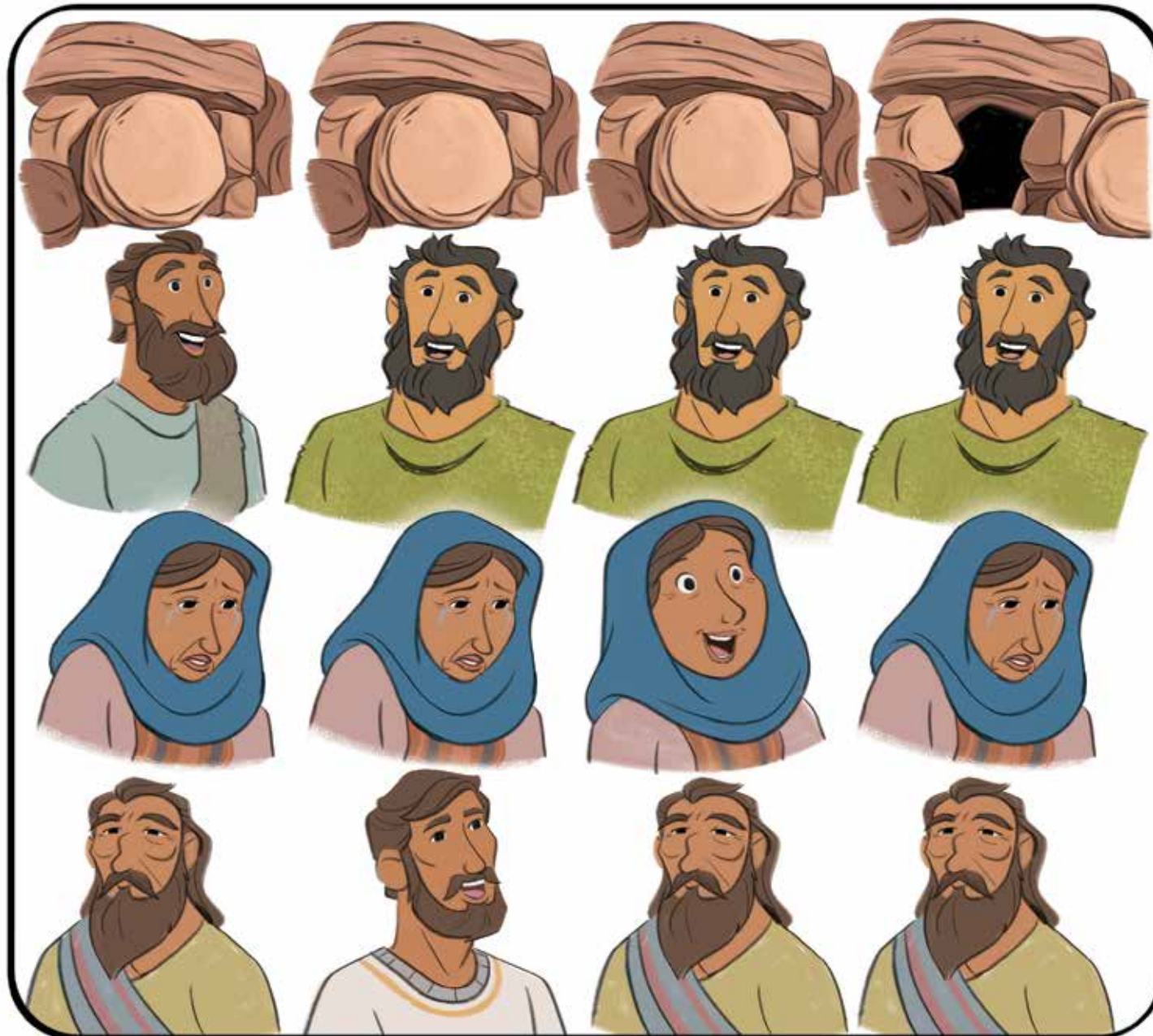


Which Is Different?

Unit 27 • Session 1 Jesus' Resurrection

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Mary found Jesus' tomb open and ran to tell Peter and John.
- Peter and John ran to see the empty tomb.
- Jesus appeared to Mary.
- Jesus rose from the dead and is alive.

KEY PASSAGE: John 11:25

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- Where is Jesus now? Jesus is in heaven.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Would you think Jesus was alive if you saw what Mary, Peter, and John saw?
- Why did the religious leaders want the soldiers to lie and say Jesus' disciples had stolen His body?
- Why is Jesus' resurrection such good news?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Choose a day this week to celebrate the resurrection. Help children understand that the resurrection is good news to celebrate every day!
- Challenge family members to share the good news that Jesus is alive with someone this week.

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- On the third day after Jesus' death, Mary and others went to care for Jesus' body.
- When they arrived, the body was gone!

KEY PASSAGE: John 11:25

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- Where is Jesus now? Jesus ascended to heaven where He is seated at the right hand of the Father.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why is Jesus' resurrection so important?
- Who else will be raised from the dead?
- Who can we tell about Jesus' resurrection?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Observe a few of your family's favorite Easter traditions regardless of the time of year. Talk to your kids about the importance of Jesus' resurrection and the hope we have because of Him.

Jesus' Resurrection

Matthew 28; John 20

STORY POINT: GOD RAISED JESUS FROM THE DEAD TO DEFEAT SIN AND DEATH.

On the third day after Jesus' death, Mary Magdalene went to Jesus' tomb. She saw that the large stone at the entrance had been moved away. Mary ran to Simon Peter and John. "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and I don't know where they have put Him!" she said.

Peter and John ran to the tomb. John looked inside and saw the linen cloths lying there. Then Peter went into the tomb and saw the linen cloths too. John believed that Jesus was alive. Then Peter and John went back home. Mary went back to the tomb and cried. She saw two angels. They said to her, "Woman, why are you crying?"

"Because they've taken away my Lord, and I don't know where they've put Him," she said. Then Mary turned around. Jesus stood in front of her, but she did not recognize Him. Jesus said, "Who are you looking for?"

Mary thought Jesus might be the gardener. She replied, "Sir, if you have taken Jesus away, tell me where you've put Him and I will go get Him."

Jesus said, "Mary."

Mary realized who He was and said, "Teacher!"

Jesus sent Mary to tell the other disciples that He was going back to the Father. Mary did what Jesus said, and she told the disciples, "I have seen the Lord!"



Christ Connection: Jesus died on the cross for our sins, but He didn't stay dead. God was pleased with Jesus' sacrifice and raised Jesus from the dead to reign as King over all creation. Jesus provides salvation from sin and the promise of eternal life.

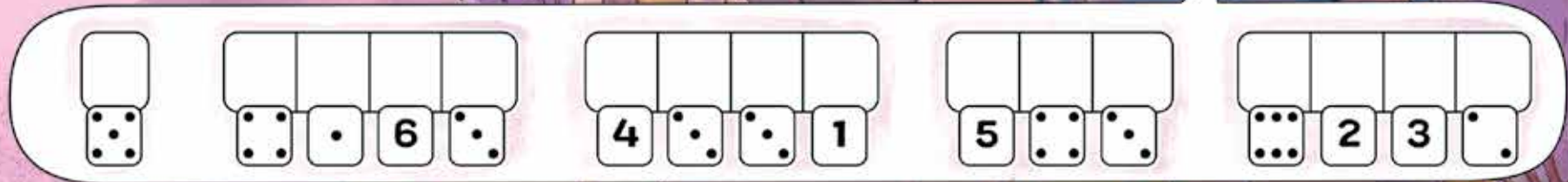
